## CHECKLIST

- BRING A TRIPOD FOR STEADY SHOTS
- TURN OFF YOUR FLASH
- FRAME YOUR SHOT BEFORE YOU TAKE IT
- SHOOT IN MANUAL MODE
- USE A LOW ISO TO AVOID GRAINY PHOTOS
- START WITH MID-RANGE APERTURE
- START WITH 2-5 SECOND SHUTTER SPEED
- ADJUST YOUR SETTINGS AS THE NIGHT GETS DARKER
